

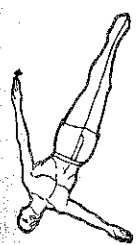

All Cheerleaders will then proceed to one of the end entrances where the winners will have easy access to the playing floor.

Sponsors of the competing 16 cheerleaders groups are asked to come to the floor with their squads. Besides getting the recognition you so well deserve; it is another way of letting the public know that cheerleading is important enough in the school's curriculum to merit a well-qualified "sponsor-coach-chaperon."

**State Wrestling Tournament**

The 1972 State High School Wrestling Tournament was held at the Seneca High School on February 18-19. The Woodford County High School, with 67½ points, won the tournament. The North Hardin High School was second with 51 points, and the Hopkinsville High School was third with 46½ points. Ken Wright of the Ballard High School was named the meet's most outstanding wrestler.

The tournament was managed by Wrestling Committee Chairman Orville Williams of the Seneca High School. It was the ninth tournament sponsored by the K.H.S.A.A.

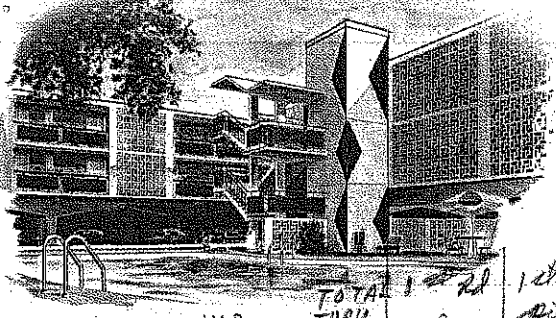
