"Weekend of Champions" will be held this week as KHSAA State Champions will be crowned in Boys' & Girls' Tennis and Boys' & Girls' Track. Both events will take place on the University of Kentucky campus in Lexington.

The Boys' & Girls' State Tennis Tournaments kickoff "Weekend of Champions" as action begins Thursday, May 31 at 11:30 a.m. at the Boone/Downing Tennis Complex. Play continues Friday and concludes Saturday.

Admission for the State Tennis Tournaments is free on Thursday and Friday. On Saturday, General Admission (good for both the semifinals and finals) will be \$5. Children six and under will be admitted free. The semifinals and finals will be played in the main stadium courts.

Action for the Boys' & Girls' Track Meet begins with preliminary competition on Friday at 8:30 a.m. (EDT). Gates open at 7:30 a.m. Admission each day will be \$5 for adults, \$4 for students, with children six and under admitted free of charge.

Saturday's finals also begin at 8:30 a.m. The schedule of class competition for both days is as follows - Class A action will begin at 8:30 a.m. (EDT), Class AAA will begin at 12:30 p.m. (EDT) and Class AA will begin at 4:30 p.m. (EDT).
