

IT IS HEREBY AGREED, by and between the _____ School,
a member of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association, by _____
Manager of the _____ ball team, and the _____ School,
a member of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association, by _____
Manager of the _____ ball team:

1st. That a game of _____ ball shall be played between their respective teams at
_____ on the _____ day of _____, 19____

2nd. At the close of the week preceding the game, each principal shall mail to the other a standard eligibility list of the players on his team, signed by the Principal or Superintendent of the institution, who shall certify that each and every man thereon is eligible under the rules on the reverse side of this contract.

3rd. At the close of the game, the manager of the _____ team shall pay to the manager of the _____ team the sum of \$_____

4th. It is further agreed that said game shall not be cancelled except on account of inclement weather, death of a player, or else by mutual consent of contracting parties. If either team or manager shall refuse to play except for reasons above, the manager of the team refusing to play shall forfeit to the manager of the other team the sum of _____ dollars; and upon refusal to pay the forfeit, team and school shall be suspended from the Association.

5th. In case of inclement weather, the manager of the home team shall have the privilege of cancelling the game up to _____ hours before the time set for the departure of the visiting team. All expense incurred by the manager of the visiting team through failure of the home manager to notify the visiting manager of cancellation of game, shall be paid by the home manager.

6th. The officials of said game shall be agreed upon at least _____ days before the game.
