Minutes of Meeting of Board of Control  
held at Brown Hotel, February 18, 1951

Mr. Hill, Secretary, Mr. Brown, Vice President, and  
Mr. O'Donnell, President, present.

Messrs. Pulliam, Schultz, Hibbs, Ellis of Bardstown  
were present to reopen the Defane Mackin case. The  
Board found no reason to reverse its decision that  
Bardstown would be suspended for failure to make  
investigation of facts which were available when there  
was a reasonable doubt as to Mackin's eligibility.

RE: Belleview H.S. at Grant, which played a non-member,  
Florence H.S. The Board decided upon leniency in this  
case since no penalty has ever been published. At the  
next annual meeting the penalty of suspension shall be  
recommended.

In exchange of eligibility lists, a period of grace of  
three or four days is permissible for reasons satisfactory  
to the Board.

Fred Borries of Kavanaugh H.S., Lawrenceburg: Attendance  
at Rugby School was under a tutor; was not in attendance  
at secondary school. That year does not count and he is  
eligible. Col. Mathis states that Borries was being  
coached for examinations to Annapolis.

Sherbet Stamper of Carr Creek was ruled ineligible some  
time ago by the president on basis of army record and  
Berea College.

Shelby Stamper of Carr Creek was declared ineligible on  
Berea record, unless further evidence can be submitted.

Alene Foley of Barbourville: Ineligible; playing fifth  
year. Forfeit all games.

Reprimand Fredonia and Farmersville, and state that any  
further irregularity will bring immediate suspension.
