Board of Control Meeting -- March 15, 1957

The Board of Control of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association met at the Kentucky Hotel, Louisville, on Friday morning, March 15, 1957. The meeting was called to order by President Russell Williamson at 10:00, with all Board members and Commissioner Theo. A. Sanford present.

Louis Litchfield moved, seconded by W. H. Crowdus, that the reading of the minutes of the February meeting be waived, since the members of the Board had received copies of these minutes. The motion was carried unanimously.

The Commissioner reported that Directors Louis Litchfield and W. B. Jones had been re-elected to the Board for a four-year period, beginning July 1, 1957, Mr. Litchfield without opposition, and Mr. Jones by a decisive vote over Prin. Don Rawlings of the Danville High School.

There was a discussion of Board proposals to be submitted at the forth-coming Delegate Assembly of the K.H.S.A.A. K. G. Gillaspie moved, seconded by Jack Dawson, that the Board submit the following proposals:

- 1. That "shall" be substituted for "should" in the first sentence of By-Law 31.
- 2. That "twelve" be substituted for "ten" in the second sentence of Tournament Rule VI-B-1 (clarification).
- 3. That the following be added to By-Law 29, Section 3: "A head coach in football or basketball shall attend one clinic in the sport involved."
- 4. A new By-Law, to read as follows: "A cheerleader, student manager, and any other student having an official connection with the athletic program shall be enrolled and in attendance at the school which he represents."

The motion was carried unanimously.

The Commissioner read some correspondence concerning the case of James J. Ryan III, currently enrolled in the St. Joseph Preparatory School. Young Ryan, whose home is in Ashland, Kentucky, had represented the Holy Family High School as a ninth grader last spring in a regional golf tournament held at Paintsville. The Holy Family School had no golf team nor coach, and the boy had not taken part in any other varsity contests. The Commissioner stated that James had been ruled ineligible by him at St. Joe under the provisions of the Residence Rule, but that he felt that an injustice was being done the boy if he should be barred from competition for thirty-six school weeks under the rule mentioned. He recommended that the Board restore the eligibility of James J. Ryan III, under authority given the Board in Article IV, Section 3-d-8 of the K.H.S.A.A. Constitution. Robert Forsythe moved, seconded by Louis Litchfield, that the recommendation of the Commissioner be accepted, and that James J. Ryan III be restored to competition at the St. Joseph Prep School. motion was carried unanimously.

There was a discussion concerning whether or not the present policy of the Board, relative to the admission to the Association of only those Negro schools in districts where integration has started, should be changed. W. B. Jones moved, seconded by Jack Dawson, that, beginning with the 1957-58 school year, any approved or accredited two-year, three-year, or four-year high school shall be considered eligible for membership in the K.H.S.A.A. The motion was carried unanimously.

There was a discussion concerning whether or not an official high school football championship should be declared by the Association. Jack Dawson moved, seconded by K. G. Gillaspie, that the chairman appoint a committee to investigate the possibilities of a K.H.S.A.A. football championship. The motion was carried unanimously. President Williamson appointed the following committee: Chairman W. H. Crowdus, Cecil A. Thornton, and Jack Dawson.

Louis Litchfield moved, seconded by Jack Dawson, that all bills of the Association, beginning February 2, 1957, and ending March 14, 1957, be allowed. The motion was carried unanimously.

The Board was then called to order in its capacity as Board of Directors of the K.H.S.A.A. Protection Fund.

Chairman W.H. Crowdus of the Insurance Committee stated that his committee would be prepared to make a full report at the April meeting of the Board.

Secretary-Treasurer Sanford presented a list of claims which had been paid since February 2, 1957, the total amount of these claims being \$2,057.25. W. B. Jones moved, seconded by Jack Dawson, that the claims as presented by the Secretary-Treasurer of the Protection Fund be allowed, and that a list of the claims be made a part of the minutes of the meeting.
