

# East Eligibility Meeting

November 16, 1992

The East Eligibility Committee met at the Kentucky High School Athletic Association Building at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, Nov. 16, 1992, for the purpose of hearing an appeal of By-Law 4, Enrollment, in the case of Chris McIntosh, a student at Jackson City High School.

Committee members present were Chairperson Claudia Hicks, presiding; Alvis Johnson, "Ozz" Jackson, Jack Portwood, Stan Steidel and Frank Welch. Also present were Commissioner Billy Wise, Exec. Asst. Commissioner Louis Stout, Asst. Commissioners Brigid DeVries and Larry Boucher and Bus. Affairs Dir. Julian Tackett. Randy Kimbrough and Gary Faulkner were present representing the State Department for Elementary and Secondary Education.

Presentations were made by Dr. Ed Lowdenback, Principal, Jackson City High School, Chris McIntosh and his mother. Following questions and com-

ments to the appellants by the East Eligibility Committee, Frank Welch moved that the Board go into closed session to discuss the case. "Ozz" Jackson seconded. Following the closed session, Alvis Johnson moved to waive By-Law 4 and declare Chris McIntosh

eligible for the remainder of the 1992-93 school year. Motion failed 4-2. Jack Portwood then moved to uphold the Commissioner's ruling and declare Chris ineligible at Jackson City High School. Frank Welch seconded the motion which passed 4-2.

Chairperson Hicks advised the appellants of the Due Process Procedure. 85

There being no further business, Frank Welch moved for adjournment. Jack Portwood seconded the motion.
